



Transportation Form 2010

Campers may travel to camp in their own private vehicles or in the camp provided van/bus.

The fee for the camp provided transportation will be \$135.00 each way and is due by April 1. Campers riding the camp van/bus will be departing from the Camp Eagle Feather parking lot at 7:00 AM sharp on Thursday July 1, 2010 (session #1) and Thursday July 22, 2010 (session #2).

Campers arriving by private vehicle should plan to arrive at Eagle Wing between 3:30 and 4:30 PM on the first day of camp. Please be on time to facilitate moving in etc. Parents will be expected to depart camp by the start of dinner at 5:30 PM. *Directions for driving to Camp Eagle Wing are enclosed.*

Coming home, the session 1 camp bus/van will leave Eagle Wing at 7:00 AM on July 22 and should arrive at the ***The Home Depot*** parking lot in Berlin, CT between 3:30 and 4:30PM. On August 12, the session 2 camp bus/van will leave Eagle Wing at 7:00 AM and should arrive at the Camp Eagle Feather parking lot between 3:30 and 4:30PM. Campers departing by private vehicle should plan on leaving camp no later than 8:00 AM on those days.
