

BOBCAT'S CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST - 2010

Camp Eagle Wing

Because of the Bobcat's short session length, we do not require them to wear the camp uniform. We do ask that you follow the dress guidelines listed below.

Still feel free to purchase camp clothing using the [camp clothing order form](#).

Clothing

- (7) Pairs of shorts (falling no shorter than 5" above the knee)
- (7) T-shirts (with sleeves, tank tops are not allowed)
- (6) Pairs of all purpose socks
- (1) Pair of hiking socks
- (6) Pairs of underwear
- (2) light weight long sleeve shirts
- (2) Pairs of jeans or long pants,
- (1) Pair of **White** shorts or pants for Sunday Chapel**(required)
- (1) Short sleeve (with collar) **White** shirt for Sunday Chapel** (required)
- (1) Pairs of sneakers
- (1) Pair of sandals
- (1) Pair of water shoes (required)
- (2) Sweat shirts
- (1) Pair of sweat pants
- (1) rain jacket or poncho (a good one!)
- (2) bathing suits, (boxer style for boys, one piece for girls)
- (1) white tee-shirt for swimming (required)
- (1) hat
- (1) fleece or similar jacket
- (1) Pair of sleeping clothes

Equipment

- (1) Mesh laundry bag
- (1) Flash light (with D batteries)
- Bug spray
- Super-soaker or water gun (**third session campers only**)
- Writing supplies
- camera (optional)

Toilet Articles

- Toilet article carrying case or shower caddy
- Toothbrush
- Tooth paste
- Hair brush/comb
- Shampoo
- Deodorant
- Soap dish with (1) bar bath soap
- (1) Bath towel
- (1) Beach towel

Optional Equipment

- Baseball glove
- Lacrosse stick
- Athletic supporter with cup (boys)
- Compass
- Books (not too many)
- Spare pair of glasses if needed
- Musical Instrument

ALL CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT SHOULD BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME.

DO NOT BRING: Any electronic device (flashlights are expected), including cell phones, i-pods, handheld games, pagers or any device that can access the internet, food, candy or gum, aerosol cans, lighters or matches, expensive jewelry or watches, pop-culture magazines, skateboards, computers, PDAs, Walkie Talkies, TV, DVD players, knives, firearms or other weapons, pets of any kind, hatchets, video cameras, or vehicles.

There is no exception for any of these items on the bus trip.
